NAFTA and other FTA compliance affects many branches of your organization ranging from logistics, shipping and documentation, sales, marketing, compliance officers and those signing/executing shipment documentation. These differing rules of origin determine whether your company's exports or imports qualify for preferential treatment. In this seminar you will also learn how to accurately complete the certificate of origin document necessary to receive the preferential rate of duty specified in each agreement. You will also learn how to legally document your activity and classify your products. The seminar will cover real-life case studies and common compliance errors.

A clear understanding of the rules of origin and certificate of origin requirements will help you:

- Verify that your goods qualify as originating materials
- Avoid fines (up to \$10,000 per entry) & other penalties for false declarations, and
